Quick Safety Checklist

Safer outdoor burning starts before you light.

BEFORE YOU LIGHT

Follow product instructions, local fire rules, burn bans, and ordinances. If conditions are unsafe or uncertain, do not burn.

BEFORE YOU BURN

- ☐ Check local regulations, permits, and current burn restrictions.
- ☐ Place the incinerator on a stable, level, non-combustible surface.
- ☐ Clear dry grass, leaves, brush, structures, vehicles, and other combustibles from the surrounding area.
- ☐ Check weather conditions. Avoid burning in strong, gusty, or shifting winds.
- ☐ Have a charged garden hose, water supply, or appropriate fire extinguisher within immediate reach.
- ☐ Inspect the unit for damage, loose hardware, blocked airflow, or other conditions that could affect safe operation.
- ☐ Burn only materials allowed by local law and your product instructions. Never use gasoline or other volatile accelerants.

WHILE BURNING

- ☐ Keep the fire attended at all times.
- ☐ Keep children, pets, and bystanders a safe distance away.
- ☐ Use the cover or spark-control components supplied for your model as directed.
- ☐ Add material gradually; do not overload the unit or create flames that exceed safe control. Keep hands, clothing, tools, and combustible materials away from hot metal and open flame.
- ☐ Stop burning if wind increases, sparks travel beyond the burn area, or conditions become unsafe.

AFTER THE BURN

- ☐ Allow the fire and embers to burn down completely.
- ☐ Confirm all ash and embers are fully extinguished before leaving the area.
- ☐ Treat the unit, ash, grates, cover, and nearby surfaces as hot until completely cooled.
- ☐ Dispose of cooled ash only in accordance with local requirements.
- ☐ Never store, cover, move, or service the incinerator while it is still hot.
